ORDER

Before the Court is a motion for preliminary injunction filed by Plaintiff Anthony Shreeve and approximately 25,000 individuals and entities (collectively, “Plaintiffs”), requesting this Court enjoin Defendants Barack Obama, Nancy Pelosi, Harry Reid, and the United States of America (collectively, “Defendants”) from enforcing the Patient Protection and Affordable Care Act (Court File No. 2). Defendants filed a motion to dismiss the complaint for lack of subject matter jurisdiction under Fed. R. Civ. P. 12(b)(1) and for failure to state a claim upon which relief can be granted under Rule 12(b)(6) (Court File No. 9). In response to Defendants’ motion to dismiss, Plaintiffs alternatively moved to amend their complaint pursuant to Fed. R. Civ. P. 15 for the purpose of establishing standing (Court File Nos. 12, 13). For the reasons expressed in the accompanying memorandum, the Court **GRANTS** Defendants’ motion to dismiss (Court File No. 9), **DENIES AS MOOT** Plaintiffs’ motion for preliminary injunction (Court File No. 2), **DENIES** Plaintiff’s motion to amend the complaint, and **DIRECTS** the Clerk of the Court to close the case.
